Know Ye That K. E. Wallace of the County of Baldwin  
having made complete payment for the whole of Section  
No Sixteen, in Township No Six (6) South of Range No  
Three (3) East in said County of Baldwin and  
Containing Six Hundred and Forty Acres more or less  
in pursuance of the Act entitled "An act to authorize  
the sale of Sixteenth Sections, and for other purposes,"  
approved January 15, 1828.

There is therefore Granted by the State of Alabama,  
the tract of land aboves described, with all  
the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said  
K. E. Wallace and to his heirs and assigns forever.

of the State of Alabama to be affixed at the Capital  
in the City of Montgomery this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January  
A. D. One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Eight

This Indenture, made the Tenth day of January in  
the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and  
eighty nine, between H. F. Castaline & his wife J. L.  
Castaline, of the first part, and John Steiner Junior  
all of Baldwin County & State of Ala. of the second part  
Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and  
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and seventy  
five (\$375) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of  
America, to us in hand paid by the said party of the  
second part, at or before the making and signing of  
these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
edged, and the said party of the second part, his heirs,  
executors and administrators, forever released and  
discharged from the same by these presents, have  
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released,  
infeoffed, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these pre-  
sents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release,  
waive off, convey and confirm, the said party of the second  
part, his heirs and assigns forever, All That
