To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**, Warrant No. *66950* for *160* acres in favor of *Marceline Heriant, Widow of Sebastian Heriant, ^{Private} Captain Guilbuts Company, Louisiana Militia, War 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the North West quarter of Section three in Township six ^{South} of Range three East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at St. Stephens, Alabama, containing one hundred and sixty acres and forty six hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL** *the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Marceline Heriant to William Jones, Junior, in whose favor said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *William Jones, Junior, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William Jones, Junior, as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
