To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**, Warrant No. *41,660* for *80* acres in favor of *Thomas J. Whalley*, Private, Captain Beauchamp's Company, Alabama Militia, Creek War

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the West half of the South West quarter of Section ten, in Township six South of Range three East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at St Stephens, Alabama, containing Eighty acres and forty ^{three} hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL** *the said Warrant having been signed by the said Thomas J. Whalley to Apphia Bleu in whom said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said *Apphia Bleu as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Apphia Bleu as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, *I, James Buchanan* **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the **SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
