The United States of America:

To all to whom these Presents shall come: Greeting
Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved
"March 3, 1855, entitled, "An Act, in addition to certain Acts
granting bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who
have been engaged in the Military service of the United
States," there has been deposited in the General Land
Office, Warrant No. 45,136, for 120 acres, in favor
of William A. Williams, Private in Captain Young's
Company, Mississippi Militia, Creek War, with the
evidence that the same has been duly located upon
the East half of the South West quarter and the North
West quarter of the South East quarter of section ten,
in Township six South of Range Three East, in the
District of lands subject to sale at St. Stephens,
Alabama, containing one hundred and twenty acres
and sixty four and a half hundredths of an acre,
according to the official plat of the survey of the
said Land returned to the General Land Office by
the Surveyor General the said Warrant having
been assigned by the said William A. Williams to
to Apphia B. Lea, in whose favor said tract has
been located.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore
granted by the United States unto the said Apphia
B. Lea as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs
the tract of Land above described;

To have and to hold the said tract
of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said Apphia B. Lea as assignee as aforesaid and
to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Buch-
anan, President of the United States of America,
have cause these Letters to be made Patent, and
the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.
