 Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the
 General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the
 Register of the Land Office at St Stephens Alabama, whereby it
 appears that Full Payment has been made by the said
 Jane Kemmon according to the provisions of the Act of
 Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making
 further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands", and the
 acts supplemental thereto for the West half of Section
 two in Two in Township Six South of Range three East
 of St Stephens Meridian in Alabama, containing three
 hundred and twenty one acres, and seventy two hundredths

of an acre - according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James Kennon.
 Now Know Ye That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided. Have Given and Granted, and by these presents Do Give and Grant, unto the said James Kennon and to her heirs the said tract above described, To Have and to Hold, the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said James Kennon and to her heirs, and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I, William McKinley, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the fourth day of October, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty third.
